### ISSUING OF VOTING DOCUMENTS

Voting documents will be posted to electors from Friday 17 September 2010.

### RETURN OF VOTING DOCUMENTS

Voting documents must be returned not later than 12 noon, Saturday 9 October 2010 to a respective constituent city or district council electoral officer.

Voting documents can be returned by post or hand delivered at the following council offices between Friday 17 September 2010 and Friday 8 October 2010 during normal office hours, and Saturday 9 October 2010 between 9am - 12 noon:

- Kawerau District Council, Ranfurly Court, Kawerau;
- Opotiki District Council, 108 St John Street, Opotiki;
- Tauranga City Council, 91 Willow Street, Tauranga;
- Western Bay of Plenty District Council, Barks Corner, Cameron Road, Tauranga;
- Whakatane District Council, Commerce Street, Whakatane.

### SPECIAL VOTING

Special voting in terms of the Local Electoral Act 2001 and the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 may be exercised at the above council offices and times.

A person can apply to enrol as a residential elector right up to and including 8 October 2010 – the day before the close of voting.

### ORDER OF CANDIDATE NAMES ON VOTING DOCUMENTS

The Bay of Plenty District Health Board resolved under section 31 of the Local Electoral Act 2001 to adopt the pseudo-random order of candidate names to appear on the voting documents. Candidate names were randomly drawn out of a hat by a Justice of the Peace on 21 August 2010.

### EARLY PROCESSING OF VOTING DOCUMENTS

The Bay of Plenty District Health Board has resolved under section 79 of the Local Electoral Act 2001 to adopt the early processing of returned voting documents during the voting period.
