To establish a Maori Health Programme and intervention programme for mothers and their children. This Programme is distinctive because:

- ?? It identifies and addresses the health needs of Maori mothers and their children from conception to the end of Kohanga Reo.
- ?? It is delivered at the most accessible place for the mother and child, i.e. Marae, Kohanga Reo and the home.
- ?? It is delivered by Iwi approved competent Kaitiaki (caregivers).

### Role of the Kaitiaki

The role of the kaitiaki is to improve the mother craft/parenting skills of Maori mothers by:

- ?? Providing education in parenting skills
- ?? Teaching mothers/fathers/caregivers to recognise when their children need professional help.
- ?? Community development.

Kaitiaki (caregivers) are available to provide the following care to pregnant women, mothers, caregivers and children aged 05 years.

- ?? Breast Feeding Education and Classes
- ?? Safe Home Visits
- ?? Antenatal Home Visits
- ?? Postnatal Home Visits
